JOB DESCRIPTION

We are hiring several managers to work at our Luscher Farm location near Portland, Oregon. These people will work together to cover Fieldwork, Propagation & Harvest at the farm. These manager jobs require a minimum of 2 years of experience working on organic vegetable farms. Candidates with additional experience will be prioritized. See below for specific job responsibilities.

Skills managing organic vegetable production and motivating the crew doing hard physical labor are both extremely important. These jobs also require organizational aptitude plus the ability to take initiative and manage time efficiently during tasks and transitions. Most of the work is done as part of a team, but the ap-

plicants should also be willing to work independently.

Our goal is to support team members in developing and deepening their skills. The crew is dedicated, hard-working and we love farming! We are looking for folks that are similarly passionate to join our team.

The Portland based farm crew will spend the majority of their time working at Luscher Farm, 125 Rosemont Rd, Lake Oswego. The people who work at Luscher Farm usually live in the Portland Metro area. Housing is not available at the Farm.

If you want to spend the next few years managing on and learning from one of the most experienced CSA farms in the Willamette Valley, this is the job for you!

ABOUT THE FARM

The 47th Avenue Farm is a unique urban farm started in 1996 by Laura Masterson. Our CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) project began on a double lot within the Portland city limits. We now grow vegetables year round on 12 acres of land within the Portland Metro Area. We also have 38 acres on Grand Island near Dayton where we grow a mix of vegetable crops, cover crops and pasture. Our CSA currently has 200 member families and we also grow for several local award winning restaurants.

All of our farm properties are managed sustainably using cover crops between vegetable rotations, beneficial insects, drip irrigation and conservation tillage techniques. This holistic farming system improves the tilth and fertility of the farmland. It also protects the woods, wetlands and communities that surround our farms.
